## STUDENT PERSONNEL

## **Asthma Medication Possession and Use**

It shall be the policy of the Diocesan Catholic Schools Office, under the aegis of the Bishop, that all schools allow students who have need to possess and self-administer asthma and other air constricting disease medication. The following conditions must be met:

- 1. The student's parent/guardian must provide the school written authorization for the self-administration of medication.
- 2. The parent/guardian must provide a written statement from the student's physician containing the following information:
  - a. name and purpose of medication
  - b. prescribed dosage
  - c. times at which or special circumstances under which medication is to be administered This information is to be kept on file.
- 3. The school and its employees are to incur no liability, except for gross negligence, arising from self-administration of medication by the student. The parent/guardian is to sign a statement to this fact. (Regulation 546.1 Release and Indemnification Agreement)
- 4. Permission for self-administration of medication is effective for the school year for which it is granted and shall be renewed each subsequent school year. (IAC-280.16)
