Connection Groups – Justin, Jessica, and John to begin setting up this week:



Jessica, Justin, and John G. will begin contacting parish formation leaders over the next two weeks to begin the discernment process of finding a date and time for your first Connections session. This session can be in-person or virtual and at a time and day that is most convenient for the group to gather. These gatherings can happen from two times per year, up to four times per year based upon the desire of the individual Connections

group.

Bishop Joensen's letter to parish formation leaders is attached to this e-newsletter. As Bishop shared in his September 26 letter, "We have some big adaptive pastoral challenges to overcome and you are at the forefront of our Diocese's prospective response...Dynamic conversation among small groups of parish formation leaders sets the foundation to address future changes; it also helps parish leaders reflect upon successes and challenges you find in parish life today."

Although there is a place and a desire to be together in larger groups, you have shared with us that the large group format is just not working as much for you. We listened to your feedback. Our hope as we begin this process is to:

- 1) encourage parish collaboration,
- 2) work on common goals and pastoral opportunities found in local formation programming, and
- 3) leverage one parish's strengths with another's challenges.


We still plan on connecting up to five times per year in larger gatherings:

- Summer Ministry Enrichment Day the 3rd or 4th Tuesday in August with Bishop Joensen
- Fall workshop (east and west) the second week of November (West is Tuesday morning while East is Thursday morning)

- PCL/CLADD Retreat for Parish Formation Leaders (the first Thursday and Friday in February)
- Spring workshop the second week of March (all day if possible in a central location)
- Closing Year PCL/CLADD Celebration the 3rd Thursday in May




people who just want to use them privately.

Even though the videos are not recorded in Spanish, you can turn on auto-translate on YouTube by clicking on the CC button (for closed captioning) and then click on the gear symbol to the right. Click on the subtitles and auto translate. Select Spanish and your video will have Spanish subtitles.

Future video projects, in fact all future projects coming out of the Evangelization and Mission Team, will have a Spanish component. Please know some legacy resources will not immediately have Spanish language equivalents. We will be working on this throughout this fiscal year.
